Qualifications:

1. The applicant must belong to any organization (university, company, etc...) in the area of the IEEE Fukuoka Section (i.e., Kyushu and Okinawa). He/she must be under 35 years old as of April 1, 2014.
2. The applicant must deliver an oral presentation in English at the International Session of the Joint Conference of Electrical, Electronics and Information Engineers in Kyushu with conference registration.
