## 1. Qualifications for Entry:

The applicant must be a current student (including graduate students) of a technical college or university in the IEEE Fukuoka Section area (i.e., Kyushu and Okinawa), must be under 35 years old as of April 1, 2015, must be an IEEE Student Member at the time of application, and the main contributor of an English paper that was either:

- (A) Published or accepted in the IEEE Transactions, the IEEE Journals or other IEEE materials, or
- (B) Presented, or is to be presented by December 31, 2015, by the applicant at a peer-reviewed international conference sponsored, co-sponsored, or supported by the IEEE (including the IEEE Fukuoka Section) and also published/accepted in the Proceedings of the conference\*.

There is no restriction on the date of publication of the already published paper. Students who received awards last year are ineligible.

# 3. Process for application:

The following two PDF files must be e-mailed as attached documents to the Student Activities Committee Chair of the IEEE Fukuoka Section (see the e-mail address below).

<sup>\*</sup>Please note: Papers presented at any International Session of the Joint Conference of Electrical, Electronics and Information Engineers in Kyushu are not eligible to apply.

- Please download the "appl\_form\_e.doc" file in the IEEE Fukuoka Section website as mentioned above. Fill in the application form, including a summary of about 200 words along with the contribution of the applicant to the paper, etc. At the bottom of the form the supervisor of the applicant is able to write an optional letter of recommendation. Finally please convert the application form to PDF format.
- 2) Please make a PDF file of your paper as cited above in Item 1. If your paper has not yet been published, its acceptance notification must be e-mailed along with the PDF file of the author's final version of the paper.
