1. Qualifications for Entry:

The applicant must be currently a student (including a graduate student) of a technical college or a university in the area of the IEEE Fukuoka Section (i.e., Kyushu and Okinawa), **under 35 years old as of April 1, 2010**, and the main contributor of the English paper that was

- (A) Published in the IEEE Transactions, the IEEE Journals or other IEEE materials, or
- (B) Presented by him/her at a peer-reviewed international conference sponsored, cosponsored, or supported by the IEEE (including the IEEE Fukuoka Section) and also published in the Proceedings of the conference.

Note: No paper presented at any international sessions of the Joint Conferences of Electrical and Electronics Engineers in Kyushu will satisfy the criteria.

There is no restriction on the date of publication of the paper. If you have received this award last year, please refrain from applying this year.

3. Process for application:

The following two PDF files must be e-mailed as attached documents to the Student

Activities Committee Chair of the IEEE Fukuoka Section (see the e-mail address below).

Fill in the application form, including the summary in about 200 words, the contribution of the applicant to the paper, etc. The supervisor of the applicant can write a recommendation letter in the form (optional). Then convert it to PDF format.
