Technical Presentation

In this symposium, we will provide Technical Presentation as a place for student presentations. The Technical Presentation is the announcement method which the exchange of opinions can be done between a general participants and the presenter. Presenters can also demonstrates using various research equipment in addition to using poster presentations (poster sessions), and fully research appeal.

Submission of Paper

Those who participate this symposium, you need to register the information on your paper first. Registration contents include "title of a research", "author", "field" and "summary (about 300 words)". For that summary, please write down clearly and simply. Then, after registering information, you need to submit a paper for review before **1st September**. Your paper will be selected depends on peer reviews. Finally, the selected authors must submit "the final thesis (camera-ready)" before **October 23th** in consideration of the comments from the reviewers and do a technical presentation at the venue based on "the final thesis (camera-ready)" within two days.

HISS Awards

The IEEE Hiroshima Branch Students Symposium will be developing students so that they can act voluntarily and tell their own ideas and research results clearly to people, and we have established an award systems. In English session, we will provide the HISS English Presentation awards.
