#### **Introduction of HISS & Registration**

IEEE Hiroshima section will hold the 22<sup>nd</sup> IEEE Hiroshima section Student Symposium (HISS). HISS is a technical symposium "of students, by students, for society", mainly managed by the students.

#### Symposium Date and Venue

Date: November 28th and 29th, 2020

**Venue: Online (Zoom)** 

#### **Technical Presentation**

This symposium will provide Technical Presentation sessions as a place for student presentations. The Technical Presentation is organized as poster sessions, in which the presenters can exchange their opinions with general participants. In International (English) Sessions, the presenters should prepare their posters in English, and explain the contents also in English. Because of COVID-19, HISS will be held online, and some changes may be made. (See the HISS website for details.)

#### Paper Submission & Review

Presenters are required to register your paper first. The registration information should include "title of a research", "author(s)", "field" and "summary (about 300 words)". For the summary, please describe it clearly and simply. Then, you need to submit a paper for review before **Aug. 31**st Sept. **23**rd. You will be notified of the review results by Oct. 16th.

The authors of selected papers should revise their paper with careful consideration of review comments, and submit "the final manuscript (camera-ready)" before Oct. 30<sup>th</sup>. Nov. 6<sup>th</sup> (Registration must be done before the final manuscript submission.) Finally, the authors can give their technical presentation at the venue.

Details of the paper format can be found at the HISS website. When you submit your paper, please access the paper submission system in the HISS website, input the necessary information (name, affiliation,...), and upload a PDF file (up to 5MB) of your paper.
