PART A - SECTION SUMMARY

A.1 Executive Summary

The IEEE Kansai Section was established in November 1998. The number of members of the Kansai Section as of December 31 was 2108 (See Item B-1). This number increased by 23 compared to December 31, 2007.



The IEEE Kansai Section Medal is presented to new Senior Member. The medal is designed with the portrait of Gennai Hiraga who had constructed the first friction generator, Elekiter, in Japan. We have given the Medals to 4 New Senior Members in annual section meeting on February 24, 2009.

B-2 Student Activities Committee

The Student Activities Committee planned the Kansai Section Student Paper Award to encourage student members of Kansai Section in their research activities of presenting excellent papers in IEEE international conferences and IEEE Transactions. In cooperation with the Award Committee, we selected 12 winners of this award in 2008.

We have five student branches; Osaka University, Kyoto University, Ritsumeikan University, NAIST (Nara Institute of Science and Technology) and University of Hyogo.
