## Event Report: 2022 IEEE CASS JJC Workshop

The global impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, which has been ongoing since 2020, has deprived us of the opportunity for face-to-face research discussions and interactions, even though we can communicate each other using online tools. Although the COVID-19 pandemic is still unpredictable, vaccination and medicine have appeared and there are signs that life is slowly returning to normal. Therefore, CASS JJC organized a workshop to encourage young CAS researchers including students, and to reawake active face-to-face discussions that had stagnated due to COVID-19.

The workshop was held on November 28, 2022 at Kanazawa Bunka Hall (Ishikawa, JAPAN). To encourage young researchers to build a broad interdisciplinary human network, the workshop was co-located with a domestic conference, <u>Design Gaia 2022</u>, and it was cooperated with many other related chapters and societies, IEEE CASS Kansai, Shikoku, and Fukuoka Chapters, IEICE CAS, VLD, reconfigurable systems, and dependable computing societies, and IPSJ SLDM. Table 1 shows the program of the workshop. It consisted of an invited lecture, an elevator pitch presentation session, and a face-to-face poster discussion session.

After the Opening Ceremony, Prof. Nozomu Togawa (2022 CASS JJC Chair) introduced IEEE and CASS (Fig. 1). Then, Prof. Hiroo Sekiya (Chiba University) gave a talk titled "Recommendation & How to Paper Submission to IEEE Transactions" as the invited talk (Fig. 2). In this lecture, Prof. Sekiya explained the significance of

submitting papers to IEEE Transactions for students and young researchers. In addition, he emphasized that the experience of writing, revising, and submitting a paper would greatly improve the abilities of all contributors even in the paper is NOT accepted.




Fig. 3: Presentation by a Student
