Special Section on Extended Editions of IEEE ICCE and ICCE-Taiwan Submitted Papers

ITE transactions on MTA to be published in October 2022

The ITE (Institute of Image Information and Television Engineers) Transactions on Media Technology and Applications¹⁾ announces a forthcoming Special Section on "Extended Editions of IEEE ICCE and ICCE-Taiwan Submitted Papers" to be published in October 2022. The special section calls for papers on electrical, electronic, and information fields. The objectives of this special section are to publish extended versions of the excellent papers that have been submitted to the IEEE ICCE or the papers submitted to IEEE ICCE-Taiwan but could not be published as full papers due to the page limitations, and finally to spread and share the knowledge from the wide range of fields. The scope is as follows; the submissions of papers revised and developed based on the ones submitted to ICCE or ICCE-Taiwan (including the papers submitted before 2022), mainly for the researches on electrical, electronic, and information fields.

Submission Guidelines:

- (1) Make sure there is enough difference between the former submitted ICCE/ICCE-Taiwan paper and the paper submitted to this special section, and be careful the latter should not be considered as a double submission because of its little novelty.
- (2) If you use the same figure etc. as the one used in the ICCE/ICCE-Taiwan paper, it is the author's responsibility to avoid copyright infringement.
- (3) Attach a copy of the paper accepted in ICCE/ICCE-Taiwan that was the basis of the paper submitted to this special section (or attach the paper simply submitted to ICCE/ICCE-Taiwan if it has not been accepted yet) at the time of submission.
- (4) If the submitted paper is written based on the ICCE-Taiwan paper that has not been accepted yet, attach a copy of the accepted version included in the proceedings to the final draft of this special section.
- (5) In the final draft that has been accepted, cite the related ICCE/ICCE-Taiwan paper in the text and mention the relationship or the difference between the two.
- (6) Papers must be submitted by March 4, 2022. Manuscripts should be prepared according to the guidelines given in the "Information for Authors". The latest version is available at the web site, <http://www.ite.or.jp/content/mta/>. Authors should write "Special Section: Extended Editions of IEEE ICCE and ICCE-Taiwan Submitted Papers" in the cover letter and choose the [Special Section] as a "Section Type" on the online screen. Do not choose [Regular]. The term for revising the manuscript after acknowledgement of conditional acceptance for this special section could be shorter than that for other regular issues (30 days) because of the tight review schedule.
