## 1 Introduction

This document includes formatting instructions for authors preparing an abstract manuscripts for APSAR2013. The authors must follow the instructions given in this document. Entire document should be in Times New Roman Font with single space.

## 2 Title and Author Details

Title is in 20 pt bold. Author names should be in 12 pts and the affiliation in 11 pts. Put a hash (#) before the corresponding author (e-mail is compulsory for the corresponding author).

## 3 Headings, Sub-headings

Headings must be in 14 pt bold. There must be a line gap before and after main headings.

### 3.1 Example of a Sub-heading

Sub-headings must be in 12 pt bold. Also there is a 6 pt space before the sub-heading.

## 4 Paper Layout

The manuscripts must be prepared using A4 paper settings, with margins as follows:

- Top = 25mm
- Bottom = 25mm
- Left = Right = 25mm

The document should be in one column format. The body text must be in 11 pt regular. Number citations consecutively in square brackets, like so [1]. The acknowledgement and reference sections should not be numbered. Don't use page numbers. Paper is limited to two (2) pages.

## 5 Figures and Tables

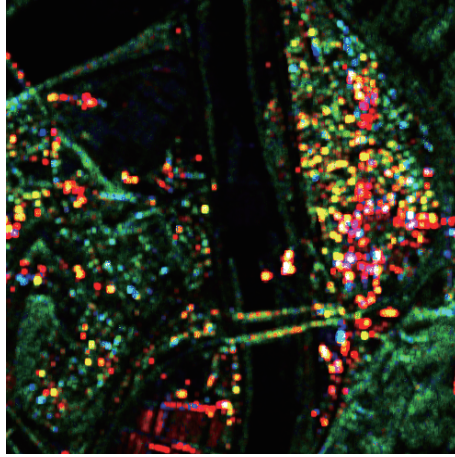


Figure 1: RGB composite image of Pi-SAR image data. Red:  $P_d$ , Green:  $P_v$ , Blue:  $P_s$

Figure captions must be placed below the figures, as shown in Fig. 1. Tables should have caption with the table number before the table, as shown in Table 1. Figure and Table captions are in 11 pt regular.
